Landing Gear Safety Switch

(Dukes Pressure Switch Part No. 3203-00)

MODELS AFFECTED:

All Electric Gear Models

INTRODUCTION:

All owners of electric landing gear equipped aircraft may install the latest switch, Mooney Part No. 950161, if they desire to lower the gear operating airspeed to a maximum of 70 MPH. At this lower airspeed, the gear will raise at maximum climb angle and minimum indicated airspeed for high altitude, short field or hot day operation. CAUTION: Margin of safety is reduced to a minimum if gear switch is inadvertently moved to the up gear position.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Remove 310046 access panel located forward of windshield on left hand side of aircraft.
- 2. Remove pressure switch by:
  - A. Removing the two AN526-632R4 screws that attach switch to 950130 bracket.
  - B. Cut wires seven inches from switch.
  - C. Unscrew switch from tee in 820020-9 line.
- 3. Install new switch by:
  - A. Screwing switch on tee.
  - B. Attach to 950130 bracket with same hardware removed in 2.A.
  - C. Add AMP 32446 knife terminals to the wires in aircraft that were cut from old switch.
  - D. Connect wires and secure as shown on attached drawing.
- 4. Replace 310046 access panel.




FIGURE 1 SERVICE LETTER 20-129
